Ultherapy

Let's face it, as we age gravity seems to pull us down in all the wrong places. From the descending brow, the sinking jowls, and the infamous turkey neck, the breakdown of collagen and skin laxity over time cause our support structures to weaken. Although having plastic surgery might be the answer for some, a proven and more subtle approach to turning back time has been developed - Ultherapy.

Ulthera, as known as Ultherapy, lifts, tightens, and tones loose skin to counteract the effects of time and gravity. Ulthera treatments are a non-invasive, laser-free, surgery-free, injection-free way of tissue lifting using ultrasound technology. The results are not as extreme as a face lift - and for many, that is ideal...a subtle more natural improvement with no downtime is exactly what you wanted.

How does it work?

Ultrasound from the guided handpiece delivers energy below the skin that initiates the natural wound healing process creating new collagen over time. The healthier collagen fibers result in reduction of skin laxity.

What is the procedure like?

Treatments take anywhere from 30 min to 60 min depending on the areas treated. A topical anesthetic is typically applied prior to the treatment to minimize any pain. The ultrasound handpiece is placed over the skin and energy is delivered to the target areas. Unlike a surgical procedure, this is done in our offices and patient's experience no down time. Short term side effects include some minor tenderness that dissipates in hours.



How soon will I see results?

The full effects of the treatment and creation of new collagen takes place over the course of 90 days. Many report visual effects more rapidly.
